

1. Background

The Community Parish Plan has been in effect now for three years (version 1.1 February 2009) and whilst a lot of activity has taken place across this period, the plan has not been tracked against or updated with any new initiatives.

The plan is divided into the following eight subject areas:

The Environment

Housing & Development

Health, Social & Community Services

Transport & Traffic

Education

Parish Council

Information & Communication

Leisure & Recreation

Each of these areas has activities associated with them, totalling 40, and categorised as follows:


A – short term; outcome to happen 2009/2010


B – medium term; outcome desired 2010 to 2013

C – long term; listed as an aspiration

There has been limited progress on the 23 priority A activities against the desired outcome above.

2. Proposed revision

Community Parish Plan priorities are adjusted as follows:

- All current initiatives in flight with 'champions' are considered priority A.
- The remaining priority A initiatives are re-prioritised priority B, with a notional commencement date of start 2013.
- All existing priority B initiatives are re-planned with a notional commencement date of start 2014

Each ward provides a representative to cover each subject area contained within the Community Parish Plan.

Any new initiative is agreed by the Parish Council and included within the appropriate subject area of the Community Parish Plan and has a representative ('champion') assigned.

All initiatives requiring funding should prepare a cost case for the Finance committee.

Priorities are reviewed overall annually in December, preceding the Finance meeting setting next years budget.


This ensures that all activity is managed against the Community Parish Plan, and a clear line of sight is established back to the top priority items.

The revised plan is published on the Parish website and maintained thereafter.
